# EXTRA EXTRA! A NEW YEAR, A NEW SCHEDULE: SURVEY RESULTS

It's here! A new school year, and a new Youth Group year, and new friends to make! And a new format! It's all new! It's loaded with exclamation points! Read on and learn more.

At the end of school last year, I conducted a survey on how we should structure Youth Group going forward. The big questions were: 1. Do we keep YG on Monday nights or move to a Sunday afternoon?, and 2. Can you adults volunteer to help?

Only 7% of respondents said YG on a Sunday was no good for them. The same number said they could not volunteer on a Sunday afternoon. So, with 93% saying either Sunday is good – or could be – that clinches it. We move to a Sunday afternoon format. The preferred time was relatively evenly distributed, with a slight edge to 4-6pm. Let's give it a try!

- You are home in time for Sunday dinner, and whatever your Sunday evening routine may be.

And now for my standard pitch. I can build and organize the Youth Group program, but I cannot – **MAY not** – do it alone. This is primarily a safety measure. That aspect aside, however, it is a fun time each week! Our children are bright, funny, surprisingly wise – well, you *know* all that. But to be part of the Group with them is truly a special thing. You will be surprised and excited by the things you will learn from them. And it requires so little!

What I am aiming for is at least eight (8) volunteers. This minimum number would mean that each volunteer would *only be needed at every 8<sup>th</sup> meeting*. Two hours on a Sunday afternoon essentially every other month. I don't think that's too much to ask to help out a program vital to our parish's future. Of course, with more, I can do more. But 8 would be terrific (*you thought I was going to rhyme and say 'great' didn't you?* <sup>(2)</sup>).


