The Mission Commission of St. Margaret's Church has approved the development of our first Open Table program, an international model that uses the intellectual capital of a faith-based community organized into a group of 6 to 8 parishioners and a Brother or Sister that has experienced homelessness to empower them to begin living into their human potential.

The Table works together to set goals, foster accountability, and implement a plan to create change. We have six volunteers for our first table, and would welcome additional volunteers. Volunteers agree to meet once a week with a Brother or Sister.
