Safari and Tour for Dageno



TOP PRIORITIES:

-Gift cards in \$20 and \$50 denominations to Walmart, Target, Home Depot & Lowes - we'll use these to help people get work boots and clothing items.; large plastic tubs and crates.; square shovels; thick rubber work gloves in all sizes; about 15-20 outdoor trash cans; at least 3 wheelbarrows.

Other high priorities:

First aid kits ; hand sanitizer bottles; cat food, dog food, kitty litter; coolers for residents with no power; bubble wrap and white tissue paper to wrap items; tough work gloves; masks/ventilators; plastic farm scoops for sand / shovels for dirt; cleaning supplies (trash bags, spray cleaner, bleach); spray sunblock and bug spray; fans/dehumidifiers; Q-Tips; Swiffers; Damprid; wet wipes; and Iron-ton 20" high velocity floor fans.
