May 13 Franklin A. Robinson, Archives Specialist at the Smithsonian National Museum of History,

will talk about his book, "Faith and Tobacco--a History of St. Thomas Episcopal Parish, Prince George's County". He looks at the role of tobacco in the early Anglican church in Maryland.
