The Power of Pledging Stewardship 2019

We're in the last few weeks of this year's Stewardship campaign, The Power of Pledging, and our matching campaign is still happening! During the matching campaign, every pledge from someone who's not pledged before; any pledge from someone who has taken time off from pledging; and any pledge increase from the previous year's pledge will be matched! We have \$35,000 in matching funds from generous parishioners.

St. Margaret's budget funds not only staff salaries and benefits, but provides funds for facilities maintenance, administrative costs, missions commission, and worship and formation, among many other things. Pledging during stewardship provides the best planning and support for next year's budget. Earlier this week, Stewardship reached 60% of this year's campaign goal of \$910,000. While we're making great progress, we hope these last few weeks push us to (maybe over!) our goals. We know this is ambitious, but currently St. Margaret's is running a deficit budget. Thanks to the endowment, we can continue to provide the support and services the community deserves. However, we are making an extra push this year to ensure we are reducing the draw on the endowment for operating expenses. — Please pledge by October 28th.


