



St. Margaret's Day School is committed to the safety and health of our students. Below you will find a list of new procedures and practices we have implemented in response to the current pandemic.

Individual families dropping off one at a time through carpool

Masks on all adults while dropping off and picking up

Masks on all staff during the day

Masks and PPE have been provided to staff

No parents in the building at this time

No field trips or visitors at this current time

Small class sizes that operate within a 'pod' or cohort, no interaction between "pods/cohorts" inside or outside.

Thermascan for accurate and touchless temperature readings

Modify air purifiers in all rooms, Air filtration in building already pipes in 20% of the outside air.

Increased supplies of wipes, disinfectant, soap, microfiber cloths, paper towels for continuous enhanced cleaning protocols

Electrostatic sprayer to clean playground and upstairs play between users

Wiping down of backpacks and lunch boxes when they arrive

All lunches in Bento type boxes to avoid over touching of food

Laundry bags and containers for separation and cleaning of toys immediately following use by children

Enhanced and continuous bathroom cleaning procedures

Individual boxes of supplies for each child, Individual containers of sensory play materials

All porous materials have been removed from classrooms to include rugs, individual sit-upons are being used for easy cleaning and individualization.

Removal of all cardboard in classroom materials and replaced with lidded plastic containers.

Rolling gates have been purchased to keep the children safe walking to the back doors of the classroom.
